

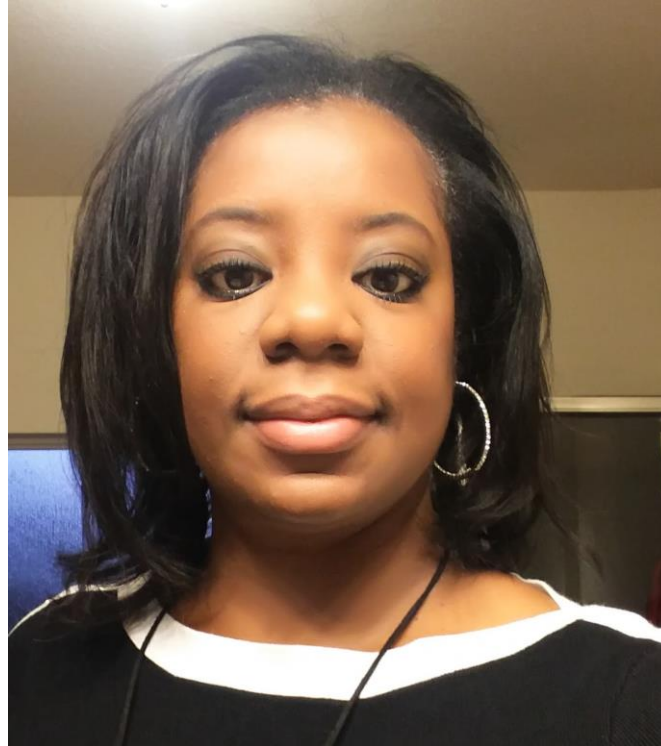

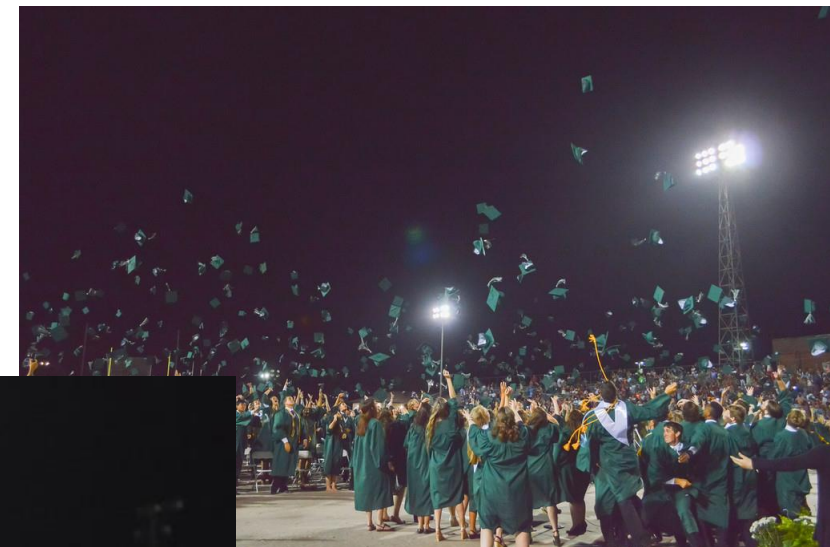

ATTENDANCE

- **To receive credit for a class Texas State Law requires you to be present for 90% of the days the course is offered**
- **Poor attendance will negatively impact YOU.**

TARDIES

- Let's be to class on time
- 6-minute passing period
- Tardy passes will be given out in House 1, 2, 3 and 4
 - Tardy pass is REQUIRED to enter a classroom
 - 3 tardies = 1 absence
- Tardies will start on **Monday, August 28th**
- Tardies will start over each 9 weeks
 - **1-4 = warning**
 - **5+ = lunch detention, ISS, etc.**

CELL PHONES AND ELECTRONIC DEVICES

- Follow your teachers' technology expectations

 - New this year – paid online through Skyward

LAPTOPS



- You are expected to have your charged laptop in class everyday
- If your laptop is stolen or misplaced, it is your responsibility to report it to Ms. Pope in the tech office (ROOM 4057)
- Remember to exhibit proper use of your laptop
- Laptop insurance is only \$20 and can be paid online in Skyward

LUNCH WILL BE IN THE CAFETERIA/COURTYARD/LIBRARY

- CFHS is a closed campus, which means you CANNOT leave campus for lunch
- Food and drink (other than water) needs to remain in the cafeteria

- LIBRARY

*****OUTSIDE Food and Drinks**

- Food needs to be properly stored when not in a designated dining area

CAMPUS DELIVERIES

- Only for academic-related needs such as lunch, homework, books, laptops, eyeglasses
- It is the students' responsibility to pick up items during a passing period
- Lunch money will be taken, by the parent to the cafeteria and deposited into the student's lunch account

Attention:

- Unclaimed lunches will be discarded at the end of each day
- After 2 days, unclaimed items will be placed in the lost and found



LOCKERS AND SECURITY

- Keep your personal items secured at all times
- Always secure your locker
- Do NOT share lockers
- Gym Lockers should be secured at all times
